

ALTEN aims to hire 3,000 new employees in aerospace and defense

To meet these challenges, the Group is announcing an international recruitment campaign for 3,000 employees by 2023, including 1,500 in France.

- Defense: the sector is also undergoing a transformation, with growing needs for modernity, cybersecurity and responsiveness.
