



Science-based Targets initiative (SBTi) validates ALTEN's greenhouse gas emissions reduction targets

ALTEN announced that its greenhouse gas emissions reduction targets have been approved by the SBTi (Science-based Targets initiative), considered to be in line with the levels required to achieve the objectives of the Paris Agreement and the 1.5°C trajectory by 2050.

The ALTEN group is committed to reduce by 2030 and compared to 2019:

- Greenhouse gas emissions from scopes 1 (*direct emissions*) and 2 (*indirect emissions*) by 59.8% in absolute value
- Scope 3 greenhouse gas emissions by 55% in intensity

By also validating its long-term environmental approach with SBTi, ALTEN is committed to achieving the Net-Zero Emissions target by 2050.

"We are honored to receive this validation, which further strengthens our environmental strategy. It reinforces our ambitions and the objectives we have set, particularly as a committed player in the environmental transition," says Bruno Benoliel, Deputy CEO of the ALTEN Group.
